 Lacey's Comprehensive Plan

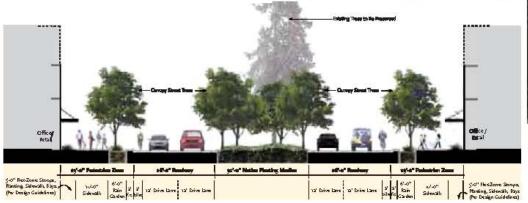


LEED® ND & NC Raingardens Purple Pipe Trails

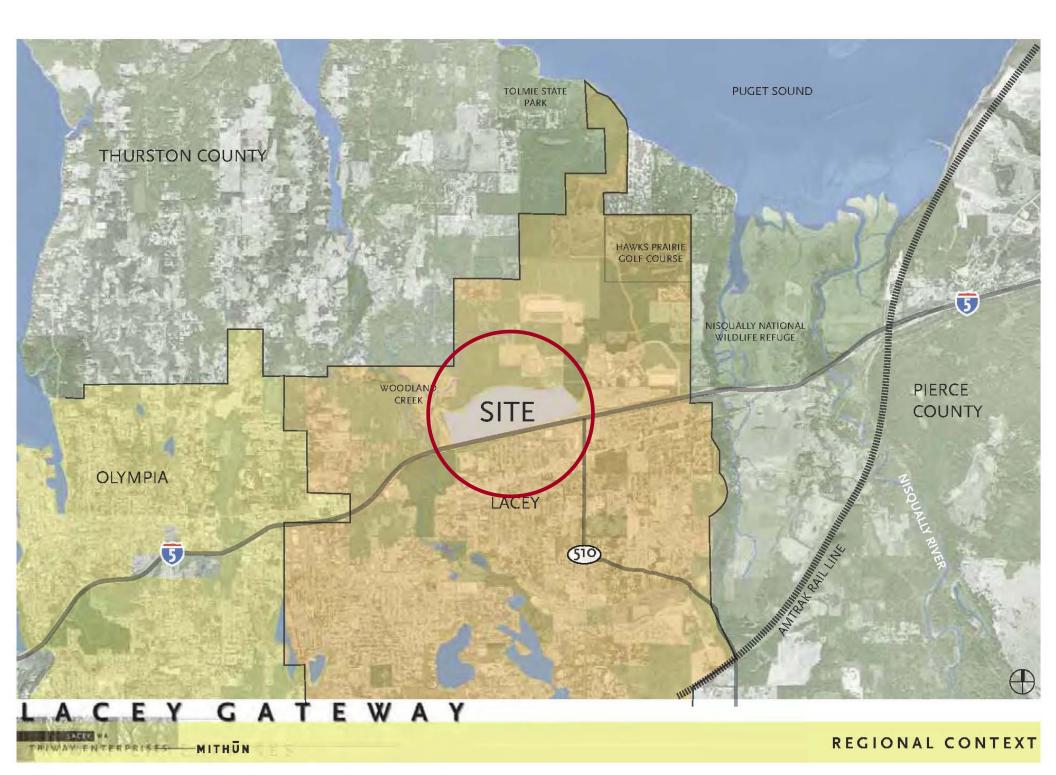

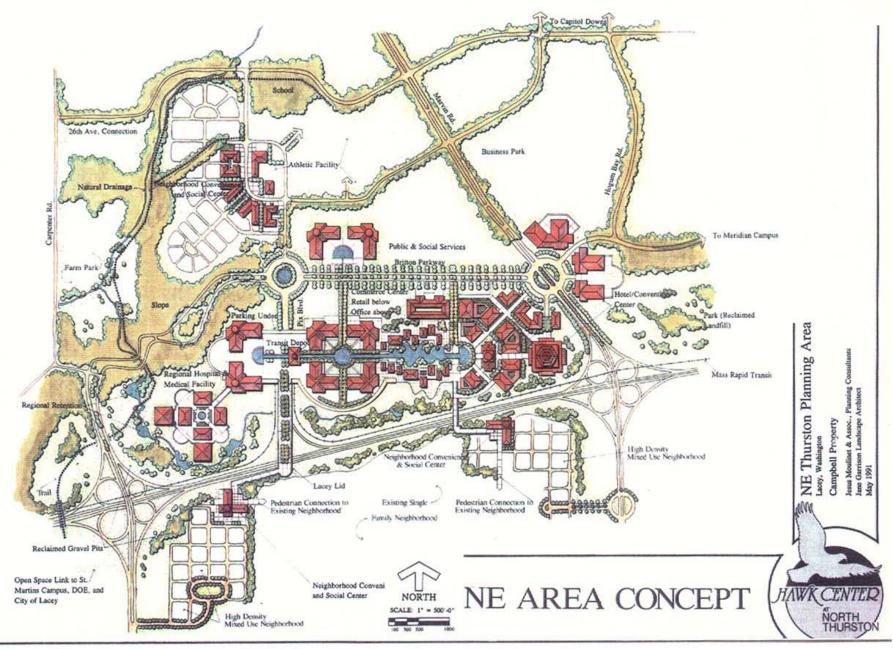

Investment: State, Local & Private

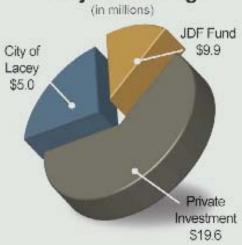

(Annual tax revenues related to Gateway Project at completion)

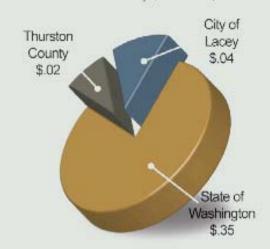
Cabela's anticipated sales activity will generate \$7 million in tax revenues annually.

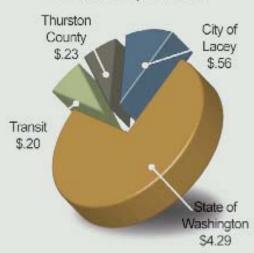
Annual Property / B&O Taxes

Cabela's Only (in millions)



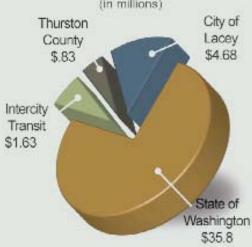
Annual Sales Taxes

Jobs & Economic Development

The Lacey Gateway Project is a job maker that will infuse millions into state and local economies.

- Cabela's will employ 350. Gateway Project: 8,000 at build-out
- Up to \$2 billion in private investment
- \$57 million in anticipated state and local tax revenue
- 400 acres of commercial, professional office, residential, retail and recreational properties

Tourism Focused

In its first year, Cabela's is expected to capture 3 to 4.5 million visitors with up to 40% from out-of-state.

- Cabela's is a destination retail store, often becoming the #1 or #2 tourist attraction
- Attracts major-chain restaurants and lodging
- 3 4.5 million visitors expected to visit Cabela's in first year
- Up to 40% estimated to be out-of-state visitors
- Thousands of NW catalog customers will visit retail store
